CODE OF CONDUCT

for Tennis & Pickleball Players, Spectators & Guests

The Colts Neck Racquet Club is dedicated to providing programs, lessons, leagues, court time, and open play, in a friendly and safe environment with an emphasis on mutual courtesy and respect. Our programs are intended to be enjoyed by all. To achieve this, all Players, Spectators, and Guests must adhere to the following Code of Conduct:

- Players must maintain a respectful and cooperative demeanor with other players, instructors, and staff.
- Profanity will not be tolerated.
- Abusive, insulting, and/or derisive comments will not be tolerated.
- Argumentative and disruptive conduct will not be tolerated.
- Mistreatment of any element of the Club and courts will not be tolerated. Players who strike the curtains, walls, nets, chairs, court surface etc. for any reason can be asked to leave the premises.
- Players may not enter the playing area until the starting bell has sounded.
- Players must promptly leave the court when the bell has sounded to make way for the next group of players.
- Players using the middle or on the far court should enter and exit behind the curtain, in the alley (the lane between the exterior walls and the curtains).
- Players who arrive more than five (5) minutes early must wait in the upstairs lounge.
- Players should refrain from unduly loud speech which could be disruptive to other players on other courts.
- Players who are unable to resolve a disagreement in an amicable manner (e.g. the score, line call), must seek the intervention of a staff member.
- Players may not modify the Rotation Sheet. Changes to the rotation can only be made by a staff member.
- Players may only bring water onto the courts. Other drinks stain and may permanently damage the court surface.
- Players may not reserve time at this Club for instruction by outside tennis or pickleball instructors.
- Players may not bring their own hoppers. Ball machines are permitted with prior approval of the Club Manger.
- Players must store bulky items in the locker-rooms, not on the courts.

The Colts Neck Racquet Club reserves the right to refuse to accommodate, to eject, or to expel Players, Spectators & Guests from the Club who fail to adhere to Club's Code of Conduct.
